Limpid, green-hued yellow. Intense, mineral- and lees-accented citrus and orchard fruit scents show excellent clarity. Develops hints of honeysuckle and iodine with air and puts on weight as well. Sharply delineated nectarine, Meyer lemon and pear nectar flavors show impressive mineral cut. The mineral quality carries strongly through the finish, which leaves behind suave honeysuckle, anise and toasted brioche notes
